The zip file contains material from practice, to assessment to re-assessment and the work required for re-assessment. Standard base grading is used on the assessment pieces in the following form:

Standard Base Grading

- Students will receive feedback on all assessments through a standards-based scoring guide using a 50% - 100% scale.
- Students will receive scoring guides in advance for all assessments so that they understand the requirements.
- The scale is as follows:

Minimal (1)	Developing (2)	Proficient (3)	Advanced (4)
The student has not met the expected standards.	The student has partially met the expected standards.	The student has met the expected standards.	The student has met the expected standards and demonstrated advanced abilities.

Following the philosophy of Standard base grading there are **reassessment opportunities**.

- Students who have not shown proficiency on vocabulary and grammar quizzes will be re-assessed.
- Students will be required to complete supplemental review work before being allowed to re-take a quiz.
- Reassessments are primarily for those students who have not yet demonstrated proficiency.
- The new grade on the re-take will replace the old grade even if it is lower than the original score because the new score represents the most recent evidence of what the student knows and is able to do.
